### Chapter 427.

Resolve in favor of the Insane Hospital.

Appropriation of \$20,000 for erection of wing to Insane Hospital. Resolved, That the sum of twenty thousand dollars be appropriated and paid out of the treasury, out of any money not otherwise appropriated, for the erection of a new wing to the Insane Hospital agreeably to the plan and specifications of F. H. Fassett, now in the office of secretary of state, to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the hospital.

Approved February 25, 1865.

### Chapter 428.

Resolve in favor of the town of Eastport.

Town of Eastport, state tax of abated, \$1,125. Resolved, That the treasurer of state abate the sum of eleven hundred and twenty-five dollars, from the state tax assessed upon the town of Eastport, for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, in consequence of the destruction of property in said town by fire, in October last, to the amount of seventy-five thousand dollars of the valuation of the said town.

### Chapter 429.

Resolve in favor of Stevens and Sayward.

Stevens & Sayward, in favor of. Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to Stevens and Sayward for furnishing two hundred and fifty-seven copies of the Kennebec Journal, daily, on order of the legislature, and for advertising in the same, notices of legislature and of its committees, six hundred and twenty-nine dollars.

### Chapter 430.

Resolve laying a tax on the several counties in this state.

County taxes, providing for.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties in the following schedule, are hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied for the purpose
