PRIVATE AND SPECIAL LAWS

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE.

The capital stock of said corporation shall consist of twenty-five thousand shares, of the par value of ten dollars for Capital. each share.

Sect. 3. The first meeting of said corporation for the choice of officers, may be called to be held at Portland, in the county of Cumberland in this state, by any three of the persons named in this act, by giving written notice to each of the other corporators, ten days before the day of said meeting; and until such officers are thus chosen, the powers of said corporation may be exercised by the six persons first named, who may, for the time being, act directors. as directors of said company, and a majority of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Chapter 90.

An act additional to chapter five hundred fifteen of the private and special laws approved February twenty-fourth, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, entitled "an act to increase the capital stock of the Searsport Bank."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. The time in which the capital stock is required to be taken up and the additional fifty thousand dollars paid in, as provided by chapter five hundred fifteen, section one, of the private and special laws approved February twenty-fourth, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, is hereby extended to the first day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

Extension of time for paying in capital

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
