### Chapter 1.

Resolve authorizing the secretary of state to purchase revised statutes for the use of the state.

*Resolved*, That the secretary of state be authorized to purchase one hundred copies of the revised statutes of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, for the use of the state; and prior to delivering any copy, or copies thereof, to the legislature upon order of either branch, he shall cause the same to be indelibly stamped in large letters with the words following:

Number of  
copies to be  
purchased.

*Library of the state of Maine; for the use of the members of the legislature, and to be returned to the state librarian at the close of each session.*

### Chapter 2.

Resolve in favor of Augusta Bank.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer be and he hereby is authorized to issue and deliver to the president, directors and company of the Augusta Bank, bonds of the state for fifteen thousand dollars, dated June first, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, payable in twenty-five years, with the semi-annual coupons attached, that fall due after June first, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, in place of nine bonds for one thousand dollars each and twelve bonds for five hundred dollars each, issued by said state, dated June first, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, and owned by said bank and alleged to have been
