Chapter 53.

Снар. 53.

Resolve to provide for the yearly expenses of the state library.

Resolved, That the sum of fifty dollars be and the same is hereby Appropriation appropriated to meet contingent expenses of the library for the expenses, \$50. current year.

Approved February 23, 1866.

Chapter 54.

Resolve authorizing the land agent to convey certain lots of land to the widows and children of deceased soldiers.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey certain lots of land in the county of Aroostook, upon which certain soldiers, deceased, with their families resided prior to their enlistment in the military service of the United States, in manner hereinafter described; and the land agent, in the deeds of conveyance, is further authorized to remit all remaining settling duties and balances due for road labor from the same: to Maria J. Siegars, widow of Thomas C. Siegars late private in company A, second regiment location of lots Maine cavalry volunteers, lot numbered fifty-seven in township number five, range three, W. E. L. S., during widowhood; remainder to the children of the said Thomas C. Siegars To Louisa H. Bryant, widow of Francis A. Bryant late private in company C. sixteenth regiment Maine volunteers, lot numbered one hundred forty-two, in township number fourteen, range four, W. E. L. S., during widowhood; remainder to the children of said Francis A. Bryant. To Eunice B. Elliot, widow of Hazen B. Elliot late private in company H, eleventh Maine regiment volunteers, lot numbered one hundred twenty-nine in township number twelve, range four, W. E. L. S., during widowhood; remainder to the children of said Hazen B. Elliot. To Ann Wade, widow of William F. Wade late private in company A, second Maine regiment cavalry volunteers, lot numbered seven, section six, in the town of Maysville, during widowhood; remainder to the children of said William F. Wade. To Lydia Cummings, widow of John C. Cummings late a private in company C, second regiment Maine cavalry volunteers, lot numbered nineteen in the town of Easton, during widowhood; remainder to the children of said John C. Cummings. To Nancy L. Toothaker, widow of Ira D. Toothaker late private in company F, eleventh regiment Maine volunteers, lot numbered forty-eight in Eaton Grant, during widowhood; remainder to the children of said Ira D. Toothaker. Provided however, that if in any case here. Proviso.
