CHAP. 73.

Chapter 73.

Resolve relating to the distribution of the adjutant general's report for eighteen hundred sixty-four and five.

Former resolve repealed.

Resolved, That the resolve approved February twenty-fourth, eighteen hundred sixty-five, entitled a "resolve relating to the printing and distribution of the adjutant general's report for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four" be, and the same is hereby repealed.

How and to whom to be distributed.

Resolved, That the adjutant general's report for the years eighteen hundred sixty-four and eighteen hundred sixty-five, shall be distributed in the following manner: the librarian shall deliver fifty copies to the governor for distribution; two copies each to the congressional library, the adjutant general's office and the heads of departments in the state; five copies to each councillor and each member and officer of the senate for the years eighteen hundred sixty-five and eighteen hundred sixty-six; four copies to each member and officer of the house of representatives for the years eighteen hundred sixty-five and eighteen hundred sixty-six; one copy to each member of the board of agriculture; ten copies to the war department at Washington; one copy to each state in the Union; one copy to each city, town and organized plantation in the state; one copy to each clerk employed in the state house; one copy to each literary institution in the state; one copy to each savings bank in the state; one copy to the office of register of deeds in each county; one copy to the office of clerk of courts in each county; one copy to the probate office in each county; one copy to the law library in each county; the remaining copies shall be reserved for public exchanges; and all copies shall be bound in the same manner as the report of eighteen hundred sixty-three; of the three thousand additional copies of the adjutant general's report, ordered on the sixteenth February, there be distributed to each member of the council and senate ten copies, and the officers of the same; and eight copies to each member of the house and its officers; also three copies to the same branches of the government for the years eighteen hundred sixty-four and eighteen hundred sixty-five.
