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**Chapter 60.**

An act concerning specie payments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter seventy-one of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-two, entitled "an act to suspend certain provisions in chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes, concerning banks," is hereby further continued in force until the fifteenth day of February, eighteen hundred sixty-eight; *provided* said banking corporations shall, upon demand, pay or tender payment of their bills, checks or drafts, in lawful money of the United States.

SECT. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

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**Chapter 61.**

An act to ratify an amendment of the Constitution of the United States, proposed to the legislatures of the several states, by a resolution adopted at the first session of the thirty-ninth congress, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*
