#### Chapter 281.

An act to make valid the doings of the town of Richmond, and to authorize said town to issue its bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis*lature assembled*, as follows:

SECT. 1. The doings of the town of Richmond at its last annual Doings at meeting, in voting to raise bounties and money to pay persons who in raising had furnished substitutes and advanced money to fill the quotas of boundies, &c., made valid. said town, are hereby made valid and of full force and effect, ex- Exceptions. cept so far as the same shall apply to persons who had paid commutation money instead of entering in the United States service or procuring a substitute for the same.

SECT. 2. Said town of Richmond is hereby authorized to issue Bonds, when its bonds, payable in ten years, with interest coupons, payable payable. semi-annually, attached, to an amount sufficient to meet the purposes provided for in section first of this act.

This act shall take effect when approved by the gov-SECT. 3. ernor.

Chapter 282.

An act additional to an act incorporating the Augusta and Hallowell Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis*lature assembled*, as follows :

#### Chapter 283.
