Chapter 390.

CHAP. 390.

An act to amend an act entitled "an act to enable the city of Portland to aid in rebuilding said city."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The first section of the act entitled "an act to enable the city of Portland to aid in rebuilding said city," is hereby amended by substituting the words *two millions* for the words "one million," in said section.

Bonds to be issued by city, increased in warrant.

SECT. 2. Said act is further amended by inserting at the close of the first section the words, *payable at the option of the commissioners in any place in the United States, or payable in England in sterling.* Also, by striking out the words, "for mechanical trades," in the third section.

Where and how payable.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

Approved March 1, 1867.

Chapter 391.

An act for the assessment of a state tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, amounting to nine hundred sixty-seven thousand two hundred one dollars thirty-two cents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. That each city, town, plantation or other place hereinafter named within this state, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged in the following lists; the same being in addition to the poll tax of one cent on each poll, a tax of five and one-fourth mills on the dollar of the present valuation for the current disbursements of the treasury, and of three-fourths of a mill on the dollar of the valuation established as a basis for the sinking fund created by an act approved January twenty-eight, eighteen hundred sixty-five.
