### Chapter 127.

Resolve in favor of the joint standing committee on the state prison.

*Resolved*, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay Thomas B. Read the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars, for expenses incurred by the joint standing committee on the state prison in visiting that institution and examining into its condition as per order of the legislature, on the thirtieth and thirty-first of January, eighteen hundred sixty-seven.

### Chapter 128.

Resolve in favor of procuring a portrait of Abraham Lincoln, late President of the United States.

*Resolved*, That the governor shall select and appoint a suitable artist, who shall execute a portrait of Abraham Lincoln, late president of the United States, under such directions as the governor may make; and the same portrait shall be placed in a conspicuous place in the State House; *provided*, that the cost of said portrait does not exceed one thousand dollars; and the governor and council are hereby instructed and authorized to draw their warrant for the amount that may be necessary to complete said portrait, not exceeding said amount.
