Chapter 131.**CHAP. 131.**

Resolve additional in favor of claimants under resolve in favor of certain officers and soldiers of the revolutionary war.

Resolved, That when any claimant to land obtained by virtue of resolve entitled "resolve in favor of certain officers and soldiers of the revolutionary war, and the widows of the deceased officers and soldiers," approved March seventeenth, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, shall establish his claim to all the rights the original party would have been entitled and where the original certificate has been mislaid, lost or destroyed; that upon due proof of his right and ownership to same, and notwithstanding such original cannot be returned to the land office, the governor and council may authorize the land agent to make conveyance to such claimant, if satisfied of the validity of his title to same.

Governor and council may authorize conveyances to claimants.

Chapter 132.

Resolve amending resolves entitled "resolves authorizing the appointment of commissioners to locate grants and determine the extent of possessory claims under the late treaty with Great Britain."

Resolved, That the resolves entitled "resolves authorizing the appointment of commissioners to locate grants and determine the extent of possessory claims under the late treaty with Great Britain," approved February twenty-first, eighteen hundred and forty-three, be so amended as to authorize the land agent, under the direction of the governor and council, to convey the lands, awarded and reported upon by the commissioners appointed in pursuance of said resolves, to the heirs and assigns of such settlers when it shall be found that such settler has deceased, or has assigned or conveyed his right in such land to another.

Chapter 133.

Resolve granting to the Penobscot tribe of Indians authority to lease their lands.

Resolved, That authority is hereby granted to any Indian of the Penobscot tribe to lease any lands he may own, with the advice and consent of the agent of said tribe, upon such conditions and under such restrictions as said agent may deem necessary to
