taxes imposed and levied in said town by authority of law, to be assessed at the same rate and subject to the same deductions as shares of state banks and other monied capital belonging to the citizens of such city or town and collected as other taxes are collected. The shares in such associations owned by persons residing out of this state shall be taxed in the city or town where said banking association is located and not elsewhere; *provided however*, that the taxation thereof shall not be at a greater rate than as above provided in the case of shareholders residing in this state.

Exception.

Proviso.

SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 210.

An act explanatory of chapter one hundred and nineteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred sixty-seven entitled "an act authorizing any city or town in this state to raise money to aid in the construction of any railroad in this state."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter one hundred nineteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred sixty-seven, entitled "an act authorizing any city or town in this state to raise money to aid in the construction of any railroad in this state," shall not be construed so as to give any city or town the right to make such subscription for more than five per cent. in the whole, to one or more railroads, or to aid in the construction of any railroad by a loan of its credit or otherwise, to an amount exceeding said five per cent., unless authorized by an act of the legislature.

Chapter 211.

An act to repeal section four of chapter twenty-three of revised statutes relating to cattle running at large.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Section four of chapter twenty-three of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
