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### Chapter 397.

An act to amend the Charter of the Escutasis Dam Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section third of the charter of said company shall be so amended that the tolls to be received by said company shall be as follows:—'For all hemlock logs hauled in above the Grist Mill Pond, on said Escutasis stream, thirteen cents per thousand feet board measure; for all other kinds of logs hauled in above said Grist Mill Pond, twenty-five cents per thousand feet board measure, and for all logs hauled into said Grist Mill Pond, ten cents per thousand feet board measure.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

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### Chapter 398.

An act to establish the line between the town of Burnham and Unity Plantation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The line between the town of Burnham and Unity Plantation is hereby established as follows:—Beginning at a stone monument on the south line of said town, at the northwest corner of the town of Unity, and on the north line of K, two, as by
