Chapter 405.

CHAP. 405.

An act authorizing David W. Campbell and others to erect and maintain a dam across Narraguagus river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. David W. Campbell, Alexander Campbell and Francis C. Campbell of Cherryfield, their associates and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to erect and maintain a dam, on their own land, across the Narraguagus river in Cherryfield, from Young's point, so called, to the opposite shore, being within, but near the head of the tide waters of said river, for the purpose of raising a head of water to propel mills and other machinery, and to erect and maintain such piers and booms in said river, above and below said dam, as may be necessary for the use and purposes of said dam and mills.

SECT. 2. Should any person or corporation suffer damage by the use of the powers herein granted, the remedy shall be the same in all respects as is provided in the ninety-second chapter of the revised statutes in case of dams and mills erected on streams that are not navigable.

Remedy for damages.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

Chapter 406.

An act to make valid certain doings of the town of Ellsworth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The acts and doings of the town of Ellsworth, at its annual meeting holden March the twenty-fifth, eighteen hundred and sixty seven, in relation to funding its war debt and taxation of bonds issued for the same, are hereby declared and made valid, and of full force and effect.

Doings at March meeting 1867, made valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
