Chapter 407.

An act to authorize the village district in Brunswick to raise money for the erection of a school-house or school-houses in said district.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Rate of interest on loans established. Sect. 1. The inhabitants of the village district, in the town of Brunswick, are hereby empowered to pay interest at rates not exceeding eight per cent. per annum, for any sums of money that may have been or that may hereafter be legally voted to be raised on loan for the erection of a school-house or school-houses in said district.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 408.

An act to make valid the doings of the town of Eastport, in paying more than six per cent. interest on town notes and town orders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Acts regarding interest on town notes and orders legalized. Sect. 1. The acts and doings of the town of Eastport, in paying more than six per cent. interest on town notes and town orders, made for town purposes, are hereby made valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 409.

An act to change the name of the Bangor Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

How changed.

Sect. 1. The corporate name of the "Bangor Company," is hereby changed to 'The Hinckley and Egery Iron Company.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
