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CHAP. 415.**Chapter 415.**

An act authorizing Drew Plantation to raise money for certain purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Powers of towns extended to Drew pl.

SECT. 1. All the powers which towns now have, to raise and expend money for the purpose of making and repairing roads, building bridges, and to pay officers and agents, are hereby extended to Drew Plantation, in the county of Penobscot.

Organization. Officers, their powers and duties.

SECT. 2. The present organization of said plantation is hereby declared legal; and said plantation may, in March next, and annually thereafter, choose a clerk, assessors, treasurer, collector, and highway surveyors, who shall have the same powers and duties relative to the assessment, collection and expenditure of money for the purposes herein indicated, that the officers in towns have.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 416.**

An act to change the name of the Sabattis River Manufacturing Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

How changed.

SECT. 1. The name of the "Sabattis River Manufacturing Company" is hereby changed to that of the 'Farnsworth Company.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 417.**

An act to change the name of Adaline J. Small.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

How changed

SECT. 1. Adaline J. Small, of Topsham, shall be allowed to take the name of Adaline J. Greenlief.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
