Chapter 420.

An act authorizing the inhabitants of the town of Eastport to hire money.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Terms of loan.

Proviso.

Sect. 1. The inhabitants of the town of Eastport are hereby authorized to hire money, or extend the payment of notes or town orders overdue, at a rate of interest not exceeding seven and three-tenths per cent. per annum; provided the inhabitants of the town shall, at the annual meeting of each year, vote to do so.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 421.

An act to authorize the town of Dover to raise money to aid in the construction of the Bangor and Piscataquis Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Tax or loan to be based on valuation. Sect. 1. The town of Dover, in the county of Piscataquis, may, at any legal meeting, duly notified and holden for that purpose, raise by tax or loan such sum of money as the town shall deem expedient, not exceeding one and one-half per cent. on the valuation made by the assessors of said town for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, and may appropriate the same to aid in the construction of the Bangor and Piscataquis Railroad in such manner as they shall deem proper; provided that two-thirds of the legal voters present and voting at such meeting shall vote therefor.

How applied.

Proviso.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 422.

An act to incorporate the Cobbosseecontee Fish Cultivating Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Corporators.

Sect. 1. Thaddeus H. Spear, John S. Wilson, and Wm. H. Merrill, and their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body corporate, by the name of the Cobbossecontee
