#### HARWOOD LODGE,-TOWNS OF HOLDEN AND BREWER.

### Chapter 439.

#### An act to incorporate Harwood Lodge, number ninety-one, of Free and Accepted Masons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. L. G. Downes, Henry R. Taylor and Jabez W. Mur- Corporators. ray, their associates and successors, are hereby incorporated into a body politic, by the name of Harwood Lodge, number ninetyone, of Free and Accepted Masons, established at Machias, in the Location. county of Washington, with power to sue and be sued, to have a common seal and change the same, to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs not repugnant to the laws of this state, with power to acquire by purchase, or otherwise, real and Powers. personal estate to the value of ten thousand dollars, to give and Capital. grant or bargain and sell the same at pleasure, and with all the privileges and powers usually granted to corporations for masonic, Purpose. benevolent and charitable purposes.

SECT. 2. The first meeting of said corporation may be called Organization. by either of the persons named in the first section of this act, at such time and place as he sees fit, and may be notified in such manner as he may direct.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 440.

An act to authorize the towns of Brewer and Holden to sell the town landings in Brewer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The inhabitants of the towns of Brewer and Holden May sell by are hereby authorized and empowered to sell at public auction, to the highest bidder, all the interest that said towns have in the town landings situate on the Penobscot river, in said town of Brewer, owned in common by said towns of Brewer and Holden, whenever said towns at any annual meeting shall vote to order sale detersaid sale.

SECT. 2. Public notice shall be given of the time and place of Notice of sale, said sale, by advertising the same in one or more of the news- how given. papers published in the city of Bangor thirty days at least before the time of said sale.

SECT. 3. It shall be the duty of the selectmen of the towns Selectmen to aforesaid to insert an article in their respective warrants for call- call meetings.
