SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 479.

An act to authorize Richard G. Hinman and Eben Blunt to erect a pier in the Penobscot river at East Hampden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Richard G. Hinman and Eben Blunt, their associates, successors or assigns, are hereby authorized to erect a pier in tide water in the town of Hampden, about three hundred feet above their pier already built.

Location and limits.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
