#### Chapter 500.

An act to establish the Sagadahoc Petroleum, Coal and Mining Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Corporators.

SECT. 1. That Samuel D. Reed, Luther Storer, Edwin Noyes, Percey Morse, John L. Morse, Daniel Wildes, their associates, successors and assigns, be and they hereby are created a body politic and corporate, by the name of the Sagadahoc Petroleum, Coal and Mining Company, for the purpose of opening petroleum, coal and other mines and minerals, and working the same, in the county of Sagadahoc and elsewhere, with power to have and to hold estate real and personal, to the value of two hundred thousand dollars, and the same at pleasure to sell and dispose of as they may see fit, and said company shall be entitled to the rights and privileges, and be subject to the duties and requirements of the laws

Sect. 2. The legislature may at any time enlarge, restrain or

annul the powers granted by this act.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 501.

An act to amend chapter two hundred fifty-one of the private laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, entitled "an act additional to incorporate the Augusta Free Bridge Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

How amended.

SECT. I. Section four of chapter two hundred and fifty-one of the private laws of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, entitled "An act additional to incorporate the Augusta Free Bridge Company," is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved February 14, 1868.
