CHAP. 508.**Chapter 508.**

An act giving additional powers to the Bangor Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

May insure  
against damage  
by lightning.

SECT. 1. The Bangor Mutual Fire Insurance Company is hereby authorized to insure against damage by lightning:

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 509.**

An act to prevent the taking of pickerel and trout in Great Bear pond and Little Bear pond in the town of Hartford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Taking of pick-  
erel and trout  
prohibited for  
term of five  
years.

SECT. 1. The taking of pickerel or trout from the waters of Great Bear pond and Little Bear pond in the town of Hartford, and in the outlet of Great Bear pond to the mill dam at North Turner, is hereby prohibited and made unlawful for and during the term of five years from the passage of this act.

Penalties for  
violation of  
foregoing pro-  
visions.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall take from the waters described in the first section of this act any trout or pickerel within the time named in the foregoing section of this act, shall forfeit the sum of five dollars, to be recovered by complaint before a trial justice on action of debt, one-half to the prosecutor and the other half to the town of Hartford, in the county of Oxford.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 510.**

An act to authorize the Bangor Savings Bank to purchase and hold real estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

May hold real  
estate in Ban-  
gor to amount  
of \$25,000.

SECT. 1. The Bangor Savings Bank is authorized to purchase and hold real estate in the city of Bangor, to an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
