CHAP. 522.  
May choose certain officers, and powers and duties of same.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 522.

An act to change the names of certain persons.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Isabelle R. Webber of Wiscasset shall be allowed to take the name of Isabelle Rundlett; Albina H. Campbell of Dover shall be allowed to take the name of Albina H. Bray; and Naomi P. Ordway of Exeter shall be allowed to take the name of Naomi P. Gilmore.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 523.

An act authorizing Alfred Lennox, his associates and assigns, to extend the Brooks wharf, so called, eastward to ship channel.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Alfred Lennox of Wiscasset, his associates, successors and assigns, are hereby authorized to extend the Brooks wharf, so called, in said town of Wiscasset, eastward into tide waters to the ship channel.

Location and direction.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
