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**Chapter 205.**CHAP. 205.

Resolve in favor of the town of Cornish.

*Resolved*, That the secretary of state be directed to furnish to the town of Cornish, in the county of York, one copy of the revised statutes, one copy of Eastman's and one of Virgin's digest, and such copies of acts and resolves, judicial reports, and other official documents furnished to towns according to the provisions of law, as are on hand and can be spared without injustice to other parties, to replace those destroyed by fire in December, eighteen hundred sixty-six.

**Chapter 206.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Lyndon.

*Resolved*, That the secretary of state be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to deliver to the town of Lyndon, for its use, one copy of Eastman's digest.

**Chapter 207.**

Resolve authorizing the secretary of state to furnish the town of Mars Hill with certain documents.

*Resolved*, That the secretary of state be authorized to furnish the town of Mars Hill, in the county of Aroostook, with one copy of the revised statutes, one copy each of the public and private acts and resolves for the years eighteen hundred sixty-two, eighteen hundred sixty-three, eighteen hundred sixty-four and eighteen hundred sixty-five, and one copy of Chace's map of Maine, said town never having received these documents.
