CHAP. 221.**Chapter 221.**

Resolve relating to the establishment of an asylum for the reformation of inebriates.

Asylum for
inebriates.

Resolved, That a commission of three be appointed by the governor and council, whose duty it shall be to obtain statistics and other information of the practical operation and success of asylums for the reformation of inebriates, and that they report the same to the next legislature, without expense to the state.

Chapter 222.

Resolve in favor of Fish river road.

\$800 for repair
of Fish River
road.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated, for repairing Fish river road; five hundred dollars, of which shall be applied in repairs upon said road from Portage lake to Fort Kent; and three hundred dollars in reconstructing or repairing the bridge over Wallagrass stream, to be expended under the direction of the land agent.

Chapter 223.

Resolve in favor of Simeon B. Folsom.

Simeon B. Folsom,
in favor
of.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Simeon B. Folsom lot numbered one hundred forty-seven in township E, range one, W. E. L. S.; *provided* that before such conveyance shall be made, said Folsom shall pay the remaining balance due for road labor, complete other settling duties, and file satisfactory bond to indemnify the state against any claim that may arise by reason of transfer or other assignment of the land certificate, dated December first, eighteen hundred and sixty.
