Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State Relating to of Maine in Legislature assembled, That we respectfully request of, and recommend to the legislature of the State of Pennsylvania the passage of an act empowering the board of commissioners having charge of the soldiers' national cemetery at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, to transfer all the right, title, interest and care of said soldiers' national cemetery to the general government upon the completion of the same.

Resolved. That the governor be requested to cause a copy of these resolutions to be forwarded to the governor of Pennsylvania, and to the board of commissioners having charge of the soldiers' national cemetery at Gettysburg, in said state.

Chapter 250.

Resolves in relation to the binding of the acts and resolves of this state.

Resolved, That the special or private acts and resolves passed Tenth volume since eighteen hundred and sixty-five, shall constitute the tenth volume of each, and that the public acts passed since eighteen hundred and sixty-five, shall constitute a volume.

Resolved, That the secretary of state shall cause a title page, Preparation of table of contents and general index, to be prepared for each volume; and that he cause the said acts and resolves to be substantially bound and properly lettered for the use of the executive and legislative departments of the government.

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty Appropriation. dollars be appropriated to defray the expenses of preparing said title page, table of contents and general index, to be paid under the direction of the governor and council.

Chapter 251.

Resolve in favor of the cities of Biddeford and Bangor.

Resolved, That the state librarian be and hereby is directed to present to the city of Biddeford for the public library of said city, one set of the publications of the Maine Historical Society; also to the city of Bangor, for the mercantile library of said city, one set of said publications.
