Chapter 32.**CHAP. 32.**

An act to change the time of holding the January term of the county commissioners' court of Aroostook county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The term of the county commissioners' court of the county of Aroostook, now required to be holden on the third Tuesday of January, annually, shall hereafter be holden on the first Tuesday of January, annually.

Term of court to be held 1st Tuesday of January.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Chapter 33.

An act to extend the corporate powers and charter of the Lime Rock Fire and Marine Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The corporate powers of the president, directors and company of the Lime Rock Fire and Marine Insurance Company, at Rockland, are hereby continued in force for three years from the tenth day of August next, for the purpose of collecting debts due to the corporation, for selling and conveying its property, and for making a distribution of the surplus proceeds thereof among its stockholders.

Corporate powers extended to Aug. 10, 1872.

SECT. 2. The charter of the Lime Rock Fire and Marine Insurance Company, of Rockland, approved August tenth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, is hereby renewed and extended for the term of twenty years from August tenth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six; *provided*, that the provisions of this section be accepted by the said insurance company, at a special meeting of its stockholders, called and held on or before the tenth day of August next, by a majority of the votes cast; and if so accepted, written notice thereof shall be given to the secretary of state within ten days after acceptance.

Charter, renewed, &c.

Proviso.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
