Chapter 86.

An act to exempt from taxation the stock of the Rockland Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

City council authorized to exempt stock from taxation according to contract.

SECT. 1. The city council of the city of Rockland are hereby authorized to exempt from taxation the stock of the Rockland Water Company and mill belonging to said company, so long as said company furnish water to said city according to contract between said city of Rockland and said Rockland Water Company.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 87.

An act to prevent the destruction of fish in Great and Little Labrador ponds, and Pleasant pond in Sumner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Destruction of fish in certain ponds prohibited for term of three years.

SECT. 1. If any person shall take or destroy any fish excepting suckers in the Great and Little Labrador ponds or Pleasant pond, in Sumner, or in any inlet or outlet of said ponds, for a term of three years, he shall forfeit and pay for each of said fish so unlawfully taken or destroyed a sum not less than two nor more than four dollars, to be recovered by an action of debt, to the use of any person who may sue for the same.

Penalty.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 88.

An act to authorize the extending of town wharf, in Kittery, thirty feet into tide water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Extension of wharf authorized.

SECT. 1. The town of Kittery is hereby authorized to extend their wharf into tide water thirty feet.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
