Chapter 29.**CHAP. 29.**

Resolves abating state taxes assessed upon township number three, range five, Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to abate and refund to the town of Sherman, fifty-one dollars and eighty-nine cents of the state taxes assessed upon township number three, range five, Aroostook county, for the years one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, said taxes having been illegally assessed in consequence of the state retaining its interest in said township until after April, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine.

State tax assessed upon township No. 3, R. 5, abatement of.

Resolved, That the county commissioners of the county of Aroostook are hereby authorized and directed to abate and refund to the town of Sherman the sum of one hundred twenty-eight dollars and one cent, of the county taxes assessed upon township number three, range five, in said county, for the years eighteen hundred and fifty-six, eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, and eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, that being the sum paid to the state treasurer by the town of Sherman on account of said taxes illegally assessed.

Chapter 30.

Resolve in aid of roads in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the following sums be, and the same hereby are, appropriated for repairing roads and bridges in the county of Aroostook, viz: five hundred dollars for repairing the state road, leading from Caribou to Van Buren, and five hundred dollars for repairing the state road, leading from Portage lake to Fort Kent, to be expended under the direction of the land agent.

Roads in Aroostook, in aid of.

Approved February 23, 1869.

Chapter 31.

Resolve for an appropriation on the road leading from Limestone to Violette brook, in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to be expended under the direction

Road from Limestone to Violette, in aid of.

CHAP. 32. of the land agent, upon the road leading from Limestone to Violette brook in the county of Aroostook.

Approved February 23, 1869.

Chapter 32.

Resolve for an appropriation to repair the bridge across the Aroostook river at Maysville.

Bridge at Maysville, in aid of.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the repair of the bridge across the Aroostook river at Maysville, said sum to be expended under the direction of the land agent.

Approved February 23, 1869.

Chapter 33.

Resolve for an appropriation on the road leading from Caribou village to the Fish river road in the county of Aroostook.

Road from Caribou to Fish river, in aid of.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of six hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of the land agent, upon the road leading from Caribou village to the Fish river road in the county of Aroostook.

Approved February 23, 1869.

Chapter 34.

Resolve in aid of constructing a road through township number five, range three, in the county of Aroostook.

State road, in aid of.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be, and the same is, hereby appropriated for constructing the state road, leading through the south part of township number five, range three, west of east line of the state, to be expended under the direction of the land agent.

Chapter 35.

Resolve for an appropriation on the road and bridge leading from Alva plantation to Bridgewater, in the county of Aroostook.

Bridge in Alva pl., in aid of.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of four hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of the
