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CHAP. 79.**Chapter 79.**

Resolve relating to the distribution of the alphabetical index of the Maine soldiers.

Alphabetical  
index to be  
distributed.

Distribution,  
how to be made.

*Resolved*, That the librarian deliver one copy of the alphabetical index to each member and officer of the present house of representatives, to the executive council, the senate and its officers, and the heads of the state departments; to the clerks of courts of record, to municipal and police courts, register of deeds, registers of probate, one copy for public use in their several offices. To the clerks in the public offices and employees in the state house each one copy. To the librarians of each public or college library, and to the libraries of incorporated literary institutions in this state, one copy. This resolve not to interfere with the distribution of one copy to each city, town and plantation in this state, and to each Post of the G. A. Republic.

**Chapter 80.**

Resolve in favor of Pillsbury and Brown.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and one dollars, the same being for two hundred and twenty copies of the Maine Standard furnished to the legislature during the present session, and for advertising proposals for state printing.

**Chapter 81.**

Resolve amendatory of a resolve authorizing the treasurer of the county of Penobscot to procure a loan to build a jail and house of correction, approved February twenty-second, eighteen hundred sixty-nine.

Amendment.

*Resolved*, That the resolve authorizing the treasurer of the county of Penobscot to procure a loan to build a jail and house of correction in said county, approved February twenty-second, eighteen hundred sixty-nine, is hereby amended so as to allow said treasurer to pay interest on said loan semi-annually instead of annually, as provided in said resolve.
