Chapter 177.

An act to authorize railroad companies to fix the number of directors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Any railroad company in this state may at its annual Railroad commeeting fix the number of directors of said company, provided the number of notice be given in the call for said meeting of an intention to act upon said subject.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 178.

An act empowering towns, cities and village corporations to make by-laws and ordinances in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Towns, cities and village corporations may make Cities, towns and such by-laws and ordinances as they deem proper, respecting the village corporations, authorized to make by-laws location and protection of trees, lamp-posts, posts and hydrants, within the limits of their roads, ways and streets; and no trees, lamp-posts, posts or hydrants, which are now located or shall hydrants. hereafter be located in accordance with the requirements of such
