Resolve in favor of the town of Princeton.

Resolved. That the state treasurer be, and is hereby directed to Town of Princepay to the treasurer of the town of Princeton, the sum of ninetythree dollars, it being for one-half of damage incurred by the breaking down of the bridge across the river between the town of Princeton and Indian township.

Resolve in favor of the state college of agriculture and the mechanic arts.

Resolved, That the sum of six thousand dollars is hereby appro- College of agripriated out of any money in the treasury of the state, not otherwise appropriated, for the completion of the college buildings already begun, and the purchase of apparatus and furniture and other necessary expenditures for the use of the state college of agriculture and the mechanic arts, to be expended under the direction of the trustees of said college.
