Chapter 24.

An act to incorporate the David Knowlton Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

| <p>SECT. 1. David Knowlton, Joshua Converse and Horatio Alden, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body corporate and politic by the name of D. Knowlton and Company, with all the powers and privileges and subject to all the liabilities and duties incident to manufacturing corporations by the laws of this state, and are authorized to purchase, hold, improve, lease or sell real and personal estate not exceeding in value at any time the sum of two hundred thousand dollars.</p> | <p>Corporators. Name. Liabilities, duties, &c. May hold real and personal estate not exceeding \$200,000.</p> |
| <p>SECT. 2. Said corporation is authorized to carry on, at Camden, in the county of Knox, the business of manufacturing ship chandlery, mill gearing, railroad stock, rolling iron, and other manufactures of wood, iron and other metals incident thereto, and the business of milling.</p> | <p>Business purposes.</p> |
| <p>SECT. 3. Said corporation may adopt by-laws not repugnant to the laws of this state, and may divide their original stock into such number of shares and provide for the sale and transfer thereof as said corporation shall from time to time determine.</p> | <p>By-laws. May divide stock into shares.</p> |
| <p>SECT. 4. David Knowlton, herein named, is authorized to call the first meeting of this corporation by giving five days notice in writing of the time and place of such meeting to each of his associates.</p> | |
| <p>SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.</p> | |
