#### WINTHROP SAVINGS BANK.

Снар. 32.

#### Chapter 32.

An act to incorporate the Winthrop Savings Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Henry Woodward, Stephen Sewall, C. M. Bailey, SECT. 1. E. Kempton, John McIlroy, C. A. Wing, Josiah Snell, Levi Jones, Albert C. Carr, J. S. Berry, George W. King, D. Stanley, P. C. Bradford, F. H. McIntire, R. T. Jones, Elijah Gott, George A. Longfellow, John May, Moses Bailey and J. R. Nelson, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the Winthrop Savings Bank, and by that name may prosecute and defend suits at law and in equity; may have and use a common seal, and establish such by-laws, rules and regulations as are necessary for the convenient management of their concerns, and not repugnant to the laws of the state. Said corporation shall have its place of business at Winthrop, in the county of Kennebec, and shall be subject to all the duties and liabilities, and enjoy all the rights and privileges conferred upon similar institutions by the laws of the state.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to receive deposits of money and issue certificates therefor; and such deposits of money shall be used as they shall deem for the best interest and benefit of said depositors, and may be withdrawn at such reasonable times and in such manner as said corporation shall appoint.

• SECT. 3. Henry Woodward named herein is authorized to call the first meeting of said corporation by giving seven days notice in writing to each person named herein, of the time and place of said meeting.

The annual meeting shall be holden in the month of SECT. 4. May, and at that meeting and all other meetings it shall require seven persons at least to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business; and meetings may be called at any other times and in such manner as the corporation may provide.

This act shall take effect when approved. SECT. 5.
