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#### LISBON MUTUAL FIRE INS. CO .- WHARF AT HAMPDEN.

### Chapter 225.

#### An act to incorporate the Lisbon Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. John G. Tibbets, Jordan Rand, Charles B. Jordan, Corporators. Jason Rand, Reuben D. Rand, James A. Harmon, William McLellan, William Tibbets, Jacob Whitney, their associates and successors, are hereby incorporated and made a body politic by the name of the Lisbon Mutual Fire Insurance Company, for the Corporate name. purpose of insuring their respective dwelling houses, barns and Purpose of. other outbuildings, household furniture and other property, the contents of any such buildings, against loss or damage by fire, and said company may purchase and hold such real and personal May purchase and hold real and estate as may be necessary to effect the object of the association, personal estate. and may sell and convey the same at pleasure. And said company may make, establish and put in execution such by-laws not con- By-laws. trary to the laws of the state as may seem necessary or convenient for the regulation and management of their affairs, and do and execute all such acts as may be necessary to carry into effect the purposes intended by this act.

SECT. 2. The first meeting may be called by any three persons named in this act by posting up in three public and conspicuous places in said town of Lisbon notice of the time, place and business to be acted upon, at least ten days before such meeting, at which time the members present may elect all needful officers, fix Officers and comtheir compensation and manage their own affairs in any way not inconsistent with the general laws of this state relating to such companies.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 226.

An act authorizing Elizabeth Johnson to extend a wharf at Hampden into the tide waters of the Penobscot river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Elizabeth Johnson and her associates and assigns, are Authorized to hereby authorized to extend a wharf from her shore in Hampden, into the tide waters of Penobscot river, in a manner not to injure the navigation of said river; provided that said wharf does not Proviso.
