#### Chapter 321.

An act to change the names of certain persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. That Vashti H. Bradley of Newcastle, be allowed to Gertain names take the name of Vashti H. Palmer; Fred Herbert Goodrich of Fayette, be allowed to take the name of Fred Herbert White; Mark William Bachelder of Bradford, be allowed to take the name of Andrew Jackson Maxfield; Belle Stanley Perkins of East Livermore, be allowed to take the name of Belle Stanley Haskell.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 322.

An act to authorize Giles Loring to extend his wharf into tide waters of Royals river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Giles Loring is hereby authorized to extend and main- Authorized to tain his wharf into tide waters of Royals river, in Yarmouth, not exceeding twenty-five feet beyond the present limits of said wharf.

#### Chapter 323.

An act to incorporate the Waterford Hotel Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

A. S. Kimball, A. A. Knight, W. P. Shattuck, Daniel Corporators. Browne, Horace Maxfield and C. L. Wilson, their associates and successors, are hereby incorporated and made a body politic, by
