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**Chapter 330.**

CHAP. 330.

An act authorizing Jotham P. Norton and John H. Leavitt to erect and extend wharves in York, into the tide waters of York river.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Jotham P. Norton of Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin, and John H. Leavitt of Portland, in the county of Cumberland, their heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to extend, build and maintain a wharf in York, in the county of York, from the shores of their brick-yard lot in said York, into the tide waters of York river, to a distance of fifteen feet beyond low water mark.

Authorized to build wharf near brick yard.

SECT. 2. Said Norton and Leavitt, their heirs and assigns, are also authorized and empowered to erect a wharf from the shores of their lot below and near Swing bridge, in said York, and to extend the same into the tide waters of York river, a distance not exceeding fifteen feet beyond low water mark.

—near Swing bridge.

SECT. 3. Said Norton and Leavitt, their heirs and assigns, are also authorized and empowered to erect a wharf from the shores of the Barrell mill privilege, so called, in said York, and to extend the same into the tide waters of York river, to a distance not exceeding fifteen feet beyond low water mark.

—near Barrell mill privilege.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 331.**

An act to legalize and make valid the organization of the Border Publishing Company, of Bangor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The organization of the Border Publishing Company, located at Bangor, in the county of Penobscot, and State of Maine, organized under chapter forty-eight of the revised statutes, is hereby ratified and legalized, notwithstanding any error or omissions in form found to exist in the proceedings taken in organizing said corporation, and all acts of said corporation, and of its officers up to the date of approval of this act, are hereby legalized and made valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
