Chapter 153.

Resolve in favor of Woodland plantation.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be and is hereby authorized Woodland pl., in to pass to the credit of the school fund of Woodland plantation, Aroostook county, the sum of one hundred and twenty-six dollars.

Chapter 154.

Resolve in favor of chapel connected with the insane hospital.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and hereby is Chapel at insane appropriated to pay for stained glass for chapel of insane hospital, of contracted for in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-one, and not delivered until eighteen hundred and seventy-two, said sum having reverted to the state treasury according to law.

Chapter 155.

Resolve in favor of Walker Darling.

Resolved, That there be paid to Walker Darling of Patten, out Walker Darling, of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of four dollars per month, commencing on the first day of January. eighteen hundred and seventy-three, and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature.
