Chapter 179.

CHAP. 179.

Resolve in favor of building bridges in Chapman plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated to aid in building two bridges in Chapman plantation; said sum to be expended under the direction of the land agent, *provided* the same shall be received from stumpage on said township.

Approved February 26, 1873.

Chapter 180.

Resolve in favor of building a road from Kingfield to Eustis in Franklin county.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated to aid in opening a road from Kingfield to Eustis in Franklin county; *provided*, that none of the above sum be paid until said road is completed to the acceptance of the land agent.

Road from Kingfield to Eustis, in favor of.

Chapter 181.

Resolve in favor of Henry Harmon.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he hereby is authorized to convey to Henry Harmon the lot of land numbered eighty-six, in township I, now a part of the town of Lyndon, Aroostook county, at the usual price paid for settling lands without the performance of building a house thereon.

Henry Harmon, in favor of.

Chapter 182.

Resolve in aid of bridge in Ox Bow plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated, to be paid to Ox Bow plantation by the land agent whenever the inhabitants of said plantation shall build and complete a good substantial bridge over Umcoleus stream in said plantation, to the acceptance of the land agent or some person by him appointed to accept said bridge.
