**Chapter 193.**

CHAP. 193.

Resolve in favor of the Western Normal School at Farmington.

*Resolved,* That the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of providing furniture, apparatus and books, and for repairs on the house, and fencing the grounds of the Western Normal School at Farmington, to be expended under the direction of the governor and council.

Western Normal School, in favor of.

Approved February 27, 1873.

**Chapter 194.**

Resolve in favor of an appropriation to carry into effect the provisions of chapter fifty-eight, public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, in relation to the establishment of meridian lines.

*Resolved,* That the sum of eight hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of the above resolve.

Meridian lines, in aid of establishing.

Approved February 27, 1873.

**Chapter 195.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Sherman.

*Resolved,* That the sum of forty-six dollars and twenty-six cents be paid to the town of Sherman, from any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, it being balance due said town for money expended for support of Robert Doyle, a state pauper.

Town of Sherman, in favor of.

Approved February 27, 1873.

**Chapter 196.**

Resolve in aid of road in township numbered eleven, range three, Aroostook county.

*Resolved,* That the sum of five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of the land agent, on that portion of the road leading from Spragueville to Daniel's mills, which lies in number eleven, range three, in Aroostook county.

Road in township 11, R. 3, in favor of.
