Chapter 206.

Resolve referring certain claims to the adjutant general.

Resolved, That the adjutant general, together with the governor and council, are hereby directed, by an examination of the pay rolls, receipts, records and all other papers pertaining to the subject, to ascertain if errors existed in the charges against the towns of Alexander, Lexington, Harrington, Vinalhaven, Bradley, Lubec, Solon, Fort Fairfield, Milford, Marion, Anson, Mt. Desert, Sullivan, Brooksville, Marshfield, Smyrna, Northfield, Eustis plantation and Linneus, for deficiencies of men under the call of October seventeenth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and ascertain if money was illegally and wrongfully demanded of said towns, and paid by them into the state treasury, and if they find, upon investigation, that such errors did exist, and that money was illegally and wrongfully demanded and paid, the governor is hereby authorized and instructed to draw his warrants for the amounts found due said towns from the state as reimbursements, and deliver them to the parties authorized to receive them.
