RESOLVES  
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**Chapter 209.**

Resolve relating to a tax commission.

*Resolved,* That the governor be, and hereby is authorized and empowered to appoint a commission, consisting of one person, whose duty it shall be to inquire into the system adopted by other states to raise revenue outside of direct taxation; and to report to the legislature such a system as may seem best adapted to meet the wants of the people of this state, and reduce the rate of direct taxation of the people; said report to be submitted to this legislature within thirty days.

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**Chapter 210.**

Resolve in favor of Peter Salmore.

*Resolved,* That there be paid from the state treasury one hundred dollars to Peter Salmore, for travel and attendance before the legislature, as representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians.
