Chapter 8.**CHAP. 8.**

An act to make valid the assessment of taxes in the town of Verona, for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The assessment of taxes in the town of Verona for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, as made by the assessors of said town, is hereby made valid. Assessment of taxes in 1874, made valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 9.

An act to incorporate the Trescott Cheese Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Isaac H. Esty, Frank B. Nickerson, William W. Leighton, Andrew J. Kelley, and John Kelley, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of the Trescott Cheese Association, with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties and liabilities provided by the laws of this state concerning manufacturing corporations. Corporators.
Corporate name.
Powers, privileges, &c.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is authorized to manufacture cheese and to transact any other business usually carried on by cheese factories or corporations for the purpose of associated dairying. Purpose of.

SECT. 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall not exceed the sum of three thousand dollars, to be divided into such number of shares as the company may determine ; and said corporation may hold real and personal estate to the amount of said capital stock, with full power to manage and dispose of the same. Capital stock.
Shares.
May hold real and personal estate.

SECT. 4. The first meeting of said corporation shall be held in the town of Trescott, and shall be called by a notice thereof at least seven days prior to said meeting, signed by one or more of the persons named in the first section of this act, a copy of which shall be given to each of the other incorporators. First meeting, where held and how called.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
