Chapter 88.**CHAP. 88.**

An act to authorize W. R. Sawyer to hold, maintain and extend a wharf into tide water in the town of Millbridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. W. R. Sawyer, his heirs, associates, successors or assigns, are hereby authorized to hold, maintain and extend a wharf, built by him in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, into tide water in the town and harbor of Millbridge.

Authorized to maintain wharf.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 89.

An act to legalize the doings of Louis M. Partridge of Stockton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The doings of Louis M. Partridge of Stockton, as a justice of the peace and quorum within and for the county of Waldo from May eighth, eighteen hundred seventy-three, to January twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, are hereby made legal and valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 90.

An act to incorporate the Calais Red Granite Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Rendol Whidden, Charles R. Whidden and Frederick T. Waite, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby made and constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the Calais Red Granite Company, for the purpose of quarrying granite and other mineral, and for manufacturing and selling the same in their various forms, with all the privileges and subject to all the restrictions, duties and liabilities imposed upon similar corporations by the laws of this state, with the right to construct, under the general laws of the state, a tramway and bridges from their quarries, in the city of Calais, to tide water, at one or more
