CHAP. 179.

Chapter 179.

An act increasing the compensation of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Commissioners of Aroostook county, to increase compensation of.

Each county commissioner of Aroostook county shall have two and one-half dollars a day, and in that proportion for parts of a day, while actually employed in the service of the county, including time spent in travelling, and also ten cents a mile for the distance actually travelled, but he shall not have more than one travel in the same case, nor pay for service or travel on more than one petition or case at the same time, nor anything for travel or attendance at the legislature connected with the annual county estimates, nor for any additional trouble or expense of any kind.

Chapter 180.

An act for the protection of fish in Chase's pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Fishing in Chase's pond.

—rights of owners

SECT. 1. The person or persons owning and controlling the water of Chase's pond, in the town of York, in the county of York, shall hereafter have exclusive control of the same, for all purposes of fishing. They shall have the right to stock said pond with black bass or other fish, and catch or take the same at any time and in any manner, except for the purpose of food at seasons when the capture of such fish is prohibited by law.

Penalty for violating.

SECT. 2. Whoever shall hereafter take fish of any kind from said pond without the consent of said proprietors, shall forfeit not more than twenty nor less than ten dollars, and a further penalty of one dollar for each fish so taken.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 181.

An act for the relief of Joseph B. Clark and Edward R. Clark.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Joseph B. & Edward R. Clark,

The justice of the superior court of the county of Cumberland is authorized, at the next criminal term thereof, to allow to

Joseph B. Clark and Edward R. Clark, prosecutors of George Sterritt, who was convicted at the last September term of said court of the larceny of a horse, harness and carriage, a fair compensation for their actual expenses, time and trouble in arresting said offender and securing the property stolen, the same as if said prosecutors had presented their claim therefor at the term when said offender was convicted.

Chapter 182.

An act to authorize the Lockwood Cotton Mills of Waterville, to change the name of its corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Lockwood Cotton Mills, a corporation established at Waterville, in the county of Kennebec, is hereby authorized to change its corporate name to the Lockwood Company.

Change of corporate name.

SECT. 2. If said corporation, by its trustees, shall vote to so change its name, the clerk of said corporation shall forthwith file a sworn certificate thereof in the office of the secretary of state.

Chapter 183.

An act to change the name of the First North Yarmouth Aqueduct Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The First North Yarmouth Aqueduct Company, in the town of Yarmouth, and county of Cumberland, shall be hereafter known and called by the name of the First Yarmouth Aqueduct Company.

Change of corporate name.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
