CHAP. 194.

Chapter 194.

An act in relation to the Border Publishing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Border Publish-
ing Co., certain
acts of, made
valid.

SECT. 1. All the acts and doings of the Border Publishing Company, located and doing business at Bangor, are hereby rendered valid in law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 195.

An act to incorporate the Dixmont Mountain Dairy Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Corporators.

SECT. 1. Asa Whiting, Columbus Peabody, Horace P. Bickford, Stephen Bickford, Jephtha Young, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of the Dixmont Mountain Dairy Association, with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties provided by the laws of this state concerning manufacturing corporations.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is authorized to manufacture cheese and transact any other business usually carried on by cheese manufacturing corporations. The capital stock of said corporation shall not exceed two thousand and five hundred dollars, to be divided into shares of ten dollars each; and said corporation may hold real and personal estate, with full power to manage and dispose of the same.

SECT. 3. The first meeting of said corporation shall be held in Dixmont, and shall be called by notice thereof, seven days prior to said meeting, signed by two or more persons named in the first section of this act, a copy which shall be given to each of the corporators.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
