### Chapter 25.

Resolve granting a pension to Charles W. Owen.

*Resolved*, That a pension, at the rate of eight dollars per month, from the first day of January, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy-five, to the time he shall become sixteen years of age, to be paid semi-annually, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, be granted to Charles W. Owen, minor child of Eben F. Owen, deceased, late a private in company K, of the ninth regiment of Maine volunteers.
