Chapter 44.

CHAP. 44.

Resolve in favor of Amos P. Cook.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be and is hereby authorized to pay Amos P. Cook the sum of seven hundred and fifty-five dollars, with interest from May third, eighteen hundred and seventy-two.

Chapter 45.

Resolve providing for the payment of the members of the constitutional commission.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury, to the members of the constitutional commission, for their compensation and expenses, the following sums: To Edward Kent, two hundred and thirty-five dollars; to William P. Haines, one hundred eighty-nine dollars and eighty cents; to George F. Talbot, one hundred ninety-three dollars and sixty cents; to William M. Rust, one hundred and ninety-three dollars; to Henry E. Robins, one hundred eighty dollars and eighty cents; to Washington Gilbert, one hundred and ninety-one dollars; to James C. Madigan, two hundred and twenty-nine dollars; to Artemas Libbey, one hundred and fifty dollars; to Frederick A. Pike, two hundred and two dollars; to William K. Kimball, two hundred and forty dollars; to William K. Kimball for engrossing, forty dollars; amounting in all to two thousand forty-four dollars and twenty cents.

Chapter 46.

Resolve in favor of Sumner P. Bradford.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized to sell and convey to Sumner P. Bradford, forty acres from north side of southwest quarter of section thirty-seven, and forty acres from northeast quarter of section forty-six, in Crystal plantation, county of Aroostook, whenever said Bradford shall have paid for the same in road labor.
