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CHAP. 54.**Chapter 54.**

Resolve in favor of Hugh Jamieson.

Hugh Jamieson,  
in favor of.Notes of Jacob  
Main, to cancel.

*Resolved,* That the land agent be empowered and is hereby required to convey by deed lot of land numbered fifty-five, in the town of Presque Isle, in the county of Aroostook, to Hugh Jamieson, of said town, and cancel and destroy two notes of hand signed by Jacob Main, and bearing date of December fifteenth, eighteen hundred and forty, and now held by the state, the said notes having been given by said Main for said lot of land.

**Chapter 55.**

Resolve in favor of Otis J. Witham.

*Resolved,* That the land agent be and hereby is authorized and empowered to deed lot number one hundred and sixteen, in the town of Easton, to Otis J. Witham, without his performing any further settling duties.

**Chapter 56.**

Resolve in favor of compiling and printing school laws.

School laws, com-  
pilation of.

*Resolved,* That the superintendent of common schools be and hereby is instructed and empowered to cause the laws of this state relating to common schools, to include the laws passed the present session, relating to the same, to be compiled, and five thousand copies printed and distributed among the several cities, towns and plantations in this state, the whole cost not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars.

**Chapter 57.**

Resolve in favor of the Bangor children's home.

*Resolved,* That the sum of two thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the benefit of the Bangor children's home.
