Chapter 80.

CHAP. 80.

Resolve in favor of the Maine insane hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine insane hospital are hereby authorized to take in charge the erection and construction of a building which shall contain a hall, for a chapel, and amusements, and apartments for other purposes, including a kitchen; also provide suitable furniture for the present brick chapel building, so that it can be used for the accommodation of patients, and for the necessary heating apparatus; and the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the purpose, the bills for the expenditure of which, shall be audited by the governor and council. No portion of this appropriation shall be expended in laying foundations for, or as the commencement of other new and expensive structures; or for repairs that shall be such in effect, other than authorized by this resolve.

Chapter 81.

Resolve providing for the exchange of certain documents.

WHEREAS, The exchange of the public documents for European publications has ceased, by reason of the death of the authorized agent of the state for such exchange,

Preamble.

Resolved, That two sets of the documents of Maine be furnished annually to the Maine historical society, one of which shall be retained and preserved by said society, the other used in exchange for works published from time to time in Europe, having interest and value to the people of the state, and calculated to promote the objects of said society; and that the state librarian be authorized to furnish one each of such volumes published since eighteen hundred and seventy, as may be needed; provided there are spare copies in the library.

Chapter 82.

Resolve in favor of the state prison.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twelve thousand dollars, for the uses of the state prison, as follows: Deficiency, six thousand two hundred and twenty-one dollars and
