Chapter 58.

An act to amend section one of chapter thirty-four of the Revised Statutes, relating to Auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one of chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes is hereby amended in the second line by striking out the word " county," and inserting instead thereof the word ' town,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows :

Sec. 1, ch. 34, R. S., amended

' SECT. 1. The municipal officers of any town may license any suitable inhabitants of their town, by a writing under their hands, to be auctioneers for one year, in any town in said county, and shall record every such license in a book kept by them for that purpose. Persons so licensed may be exempted from any liability to deduct two and one-half per cent. from the gross amount of sales, as provided in section three.'

Chapter 59.

An act to amend section one, chapter ninety-seven, of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred seventy-three.
