Chapter 305.

CHAP. 305.

An act to authorize Camden Village Corporation to build a Hall.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Section two of the "act to incorporate the Camden Village Corporation," approved February fourteen, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: 'and for building or assisting in building a village hall, the amount invested for that purpose not to exceed eight thousand dollars, to be raised by loan instead of assessment, on a time not exceeding ten years, if said corporation shall so vote,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

'SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized and vested with power, at any legal meeting called for the purpose, to raise money to defray the expenses of a night watch, a police force, and all other necessary measures for the better security of life and property, and for the promotion of good order and quiet within its limits; for the purchase, repair and preservation of one or more fire engines, engine houses, hose, buckets, ladders, or other apparatus for the extinguishment of fires; for the construction of reservoirs and aqueducts to supply water; for organizing and maintaining within the limits of said territory, an efficient fire department, and for building or assisting in building a village hall, the amount invested for that purpose not to exceed eight thousand dollars, to be raised by loan instead of assessment, on a time not exceeding ten years, if said corporation shall so vote.'

Vested powers

SECT. 2. This amendment shall be submitted for the ratification of the legal voters of said corporation, at any legal meeting thereof, and if accepted at said meeting, it shall take effect as a law.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
